



INSPECTION CHECKLIST

This inspection of the vehicle is to determine overall mechanical condition. Some parts that are listed for inspection may not be covered by the warranty. Engine, transmission and drive axle must be the same as original equipment specified for the vehicle and meet all applicable federal regulations to be eligible for coverage.

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General items:

- Odometer reading is supported by the general condition of the vehicle.
- Oil is clean and at the prescribed level.
- Oil leaks, if any, have been corrected.
- Standard or automatic transmission fluid is at the prescribed level, with no contamination.
- Coolant is at the prescribed level, with no contamination.
- Cooling system shows no evidence of leaks.
- Power steering pump reservoir and gear box are at the prescribed fluid levels and the system shows no evidence of leaks.
- Brake master cylinder is at the prescribed fluid level and shows no evidence of leaks.
- Battery is at prescribed levels and cables are free of corrosion.
- Air filter is clean.
- Transmission case is free of cracks, showing no signs of leaks.
- Rear axle (and front axle on 4x4s) fluid is at the prescribed level.
- All fluid and oil leaks have been corrected.

Road test:

- Engine is operating properly and shows no obvious signs of problems, such as smoking, oil leaks, and so forth.
- Engine oil pressure and operating temperatures are within the normal limits.
- Automatic transmission is shifting properly and smoothly.
- Any vibrations in the drive line have been corrected.
- Electrical switches have been tested and are working. Switches exhibiting problems have been repaired or replaced.

- Air conditioner was inspected for proper operation and is free of Freon leaks.
- Steering control was checked for proper operation.
- Brakes were checked for proper operation.
- Parking brake was checked for proper operation.
- Conditions causing unusual noises in the engine, transmission, drive shaft, universal joints, and rear axle were corrected.
- Emission controls are in working order and meet both state and federal requirements.
- Odometer is in working order.

Interior – exterior:

- Bumper fascia, guards, and finish meet acceptable standards. Grill emblems are attached. Lamps are attached and operational.
- Hood, fender, trunk lid, and truck bed trim/emblems are attached. Lamps are attached and operational.
- Door trim is attached and finish is acceptable. Wheel covers are attached and finish is acceptable.
- Glass shows no cracks, chips, or scratches. Wiper arms and blades are intact and operational.
- Instrument panel/console controls are functional and trim is attached. Seat trim is attached; cushions/upholstery are acceptable.
- Accessories (lights, gauges, radio, power seats, alarm system) are all operational. Door panel controls are operational; trim is attached.
- Carpet, floor mats, headliner, luggage compartment, and cargo area trim are in acceptable condition; cargo area trim is attached. Interior lamps are operational.
